

ORDINANCE 2024-2 AMENDED
ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE NO THRU TRUCKS
ON 450TH AVENUE, 710TH STREET, AND 490TH AVENUE

The Town of Ellsworth, Pierce County Wisconsin, ordains as follows:

Section 1. **AUTHORITY.** This ordinance is enacted pursuant to power granted by virtue of the Wisconsin Statutes, including Section 349.17 Wisconsin Stats, and by its adoption of village powers under Section 60.10. The Town Board finds a need exists for this ordinance to promote the general public welfare, to protect the public safety from overweight vehicles and to minimize damage to roads maintained by the Town by the establishment of reasonable weight limits for vehicles traveling on roads maintained by the Town.

Section 2. **HEAVY TRAFFIC.** **Heavy traffic, as defined by Wisconsin Statutes 349.17(2)** means all vehicles not operating completely on pneumatic tires and all vehicles or combination of vehicles, other than motor buses, designed or used for transporting property of any nature and have a gross weight of more than 6,000 pounds.

Section 3. **NO THRU TRUCK ROAD.** A No Thru truck is one that passes thru the town without having origin or destination in the town and does not make delivery at any residence or business which has entrance on said road.

The Town of Ellsworth establishes, by this ordinance, the following roads in the Town of Ellsworth as “NO THRU TRUCK” roads and the town chair or his designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on said roads on or before the effective date of this ordinance:

All of 450th Avenue
710th Street from 490th Avenue south to 410th Avenue

On December 2, 2024 Town Board meeting, motion by Gordon Borner, seconded by Brad Ristow to amend Ordinance 2024-2 to include

490th Avenue from County Rd C east to 610th Avenue.

Motion carried.

Section 4. **VIOLATION.** Violators shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$500.00.

Section 5. **EFFECT.** This ordinance takes effect upon posting and publication in newspaper.
